### Pre- application process for the NAIST Entrance Exam

#### Preparation (6 months-1 year prior to 1<sup>st</sup> day of the application acceptance period)

Check the Graduate School of Science and Technology list of laboratories for a laboratory that suits your research theme/interests.

#### Apply to the Pre-Application Support Desk (2-6 months prior to 1<sup>st</sup> day of the application acceptance period)

#### 1 or 2 weeks after you apply

The preferred supervising professor will decide whether contact can be initiated. The Pre-Application Support Desk will notify you of the result. If you receive a notice of approval, you can contact the professor.

Contact your preferred supervising professor.

#### 1 month after contacting preferred supervising professor

Receive the “Notice of Scheduled Laboratory Assignment” from the Pre-Application Support Desk after you contact with preferred supervising professor. Please keep Notice of Scheduled Laboratory Assignment. Those who receive the notification can apply for Entrance exam.

#### Application period

Apply for Entrance Exam.

Do not submit Tentative Laboratory Acceptance Notification with other application documents.

Take Entrance Exam.

Successful applicants will move on to the entrance procedures.
